



Ivan Schewitz is a cardiothoracic surgeon in Johannesburg. He is an honorary consultant at Pretoria University and trained under Profs Barnard and Kingsley. Dr Schewitz introduced minimally invasive thoracic surgery into South Africa (SA). The Nuss procedure for pectus excavatum was first performed in SA by him and has now become the standard procedure for this condition. Over the last few years, he has run a number of minimally invasive thoracic surgery workshops, in an effort to popularise this aspect of thoracic surgery. Dr Schewitz is an executive member of the Chest Wall International Group, as well as the surgical representative of the SA Thoracic Society. He has contributed to many local and international meetings as a presenter, as well as a number of peer-reviewed articles, and a book chapter for a book on uniportal thoracic surgery.
